Rollovers can be made by visiting csc.gov.au/combine, or completing the **Transfer your super to ADF Super** form available on csc.gov.au or by contacting the fund you would like to transfer your super from.

Eligible members can gain secure access to their account to view and update details, select investment options and make contributions to the fund by setting up a member services online account at csc.gov.au/Members/Log-in

Employer contributions are made to ADF Super through an online clearing house service. Non-Defence employers should use their existing clearing house solution to make Superannuation Guarantee payments to ADF Super.
