Boost Your Super



In early November we launched a [Boost Your Super](#) pilot with some of our ADF Super and PSSap customers.

What is it? Boost Your Super allows you to make free and easy contributions to your super balance when you shop online with its partner retailers.

We're the first super fund to partner with Boost Your Super, so any eligible CSC customers who participate in the pilot get a 50% boost on top of the percentage for that store*. The pilot ends on 28 February 2022.
